

CRIMINAL RECORD

As Bill Mohan, #7688, received State Penitentiary, Deer Lodge, Montana, December 2, 1923, from Valley County, Montana, to serve a term of 2-4 years for grand larceny (car theft). Paroled December 31, 1924.

As William Mahan, #3821, received State Penitentiary, Boise, Idaho, September 24, 1927, to serve a term of 20 years for robbery. Pardoned by the State Pardon Board, June 1, 1933.

William Mahan is wanted for the kidnaping of George Weyerhaeuser at Tacoma, Washington, on May 24, 1935. An indictment was returned by the Federal Grand Jury at Tacoma, Washington, on June 19, 1935, charging Mahan, together with Harmon Metz Waley and Mrs. Margaret E. Waley, with this kidnaping. On the same date, the Federal Grand Jury at Tacoma returned an indictment charging Mahan and Harmon Metz Waley with use of the U. S. Mails to extort \$200,000.00 from the parents of George Weyerhaeuser.

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
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
